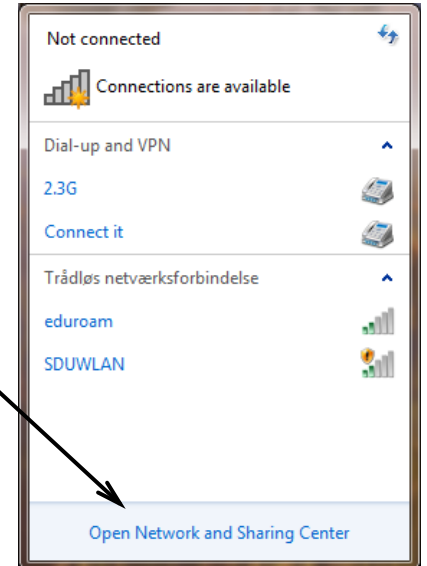


How to connect to eduroam on SDU.

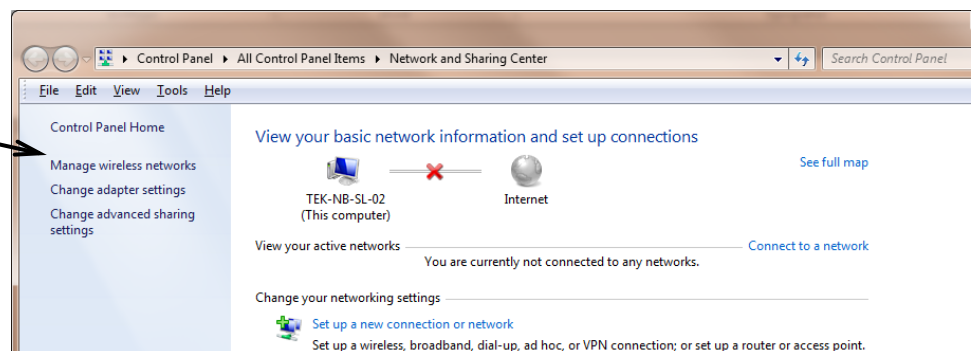
As a student or employee you have access to two different networks. One is called "SDUWLAN" and the other one is called "eduroam".

This guide will show you how to connect to "eduroam".

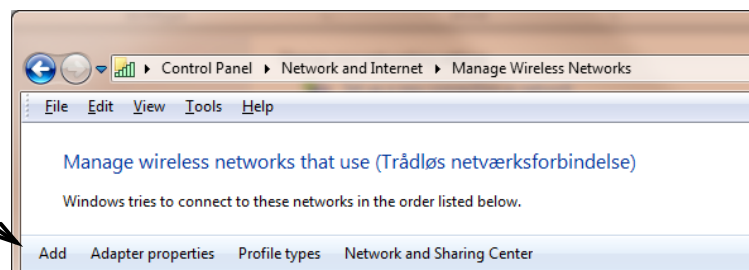
- Single left click on the wireless icon, in the right bottom corner of the screen and choose "Open Network and Sharing Center".



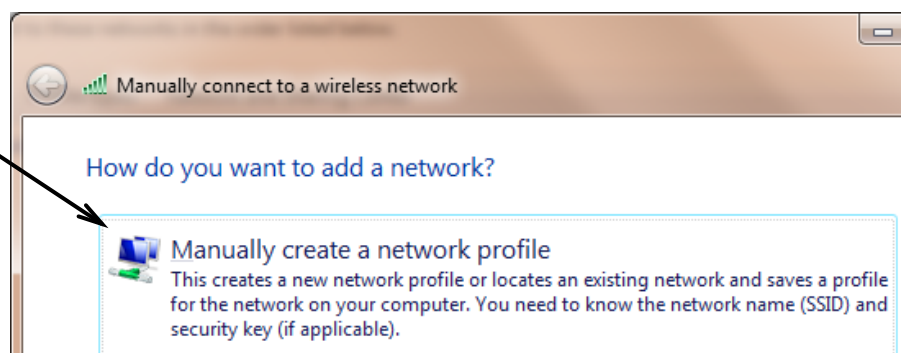
- Click on "Manage wireless networks".



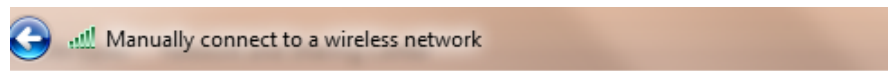
- And add a new configuration. Click "Add".



- Click on "Manually create a network profile".



Type in as following. "Network name"
eduroam,



Enter information for the wireless network you want to add

set the "Security type" to **802.1x**
and click **next**.

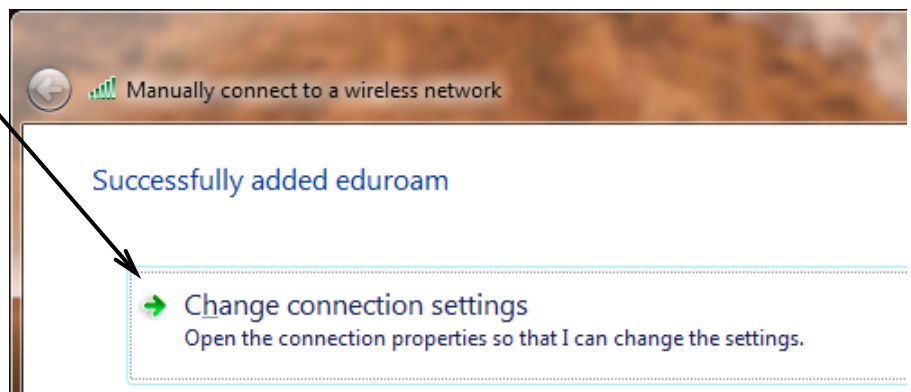

- Now click on the "Change connection settings" to change the settings.



- Choose the Security tap. "Security type" **WPA-Enterprise**

and then click **Settings**.

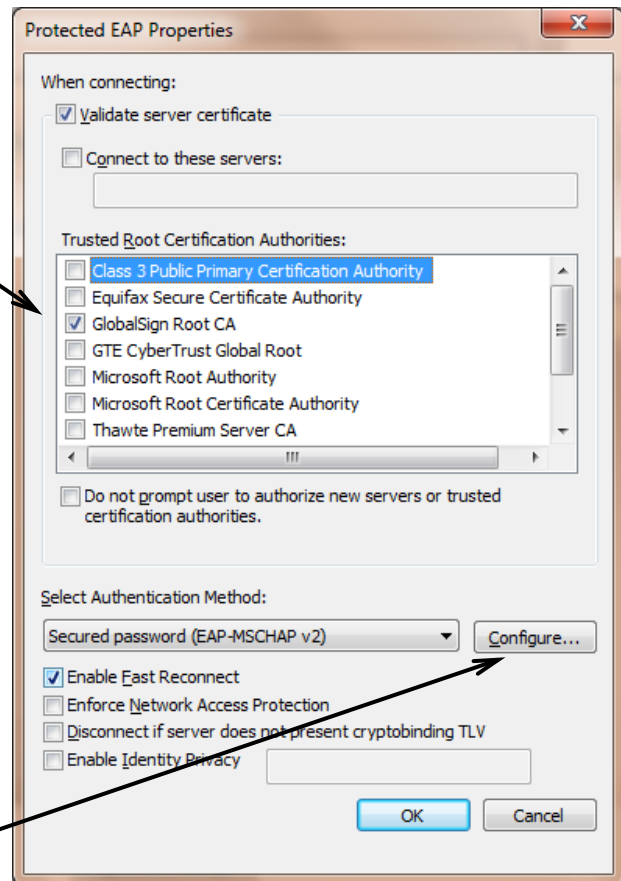

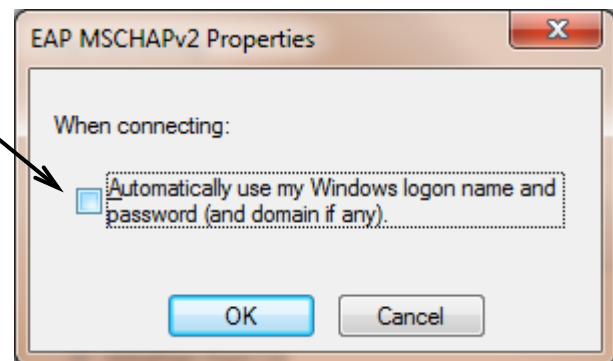

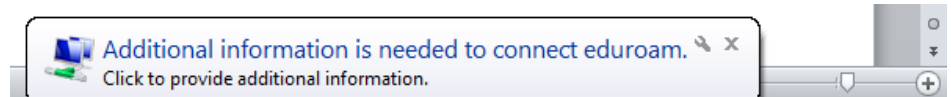
- In "Protected EAP Properties" dialog, select "GlobalSign Root CA". Press "OK"



- Click "Configure" and de-select "Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)".



- After you click "Ok" a small box should popup in the right bottom corner of the screen. Left click on this box.



- Press "Connect" and type in your credentials. "User name" is your **FULL SDU Email address** and "Password" is the SDU password.
