❖ Horizon 2020 Week at SDU – Save the Dates 19-21st of November

SDU Grants Office and South Denmark European Office have joint forces in order to give researcher and staff at University of Southern Denmark a thorough introduction to Horizon 2020. **This means that week 47 has been declared Horizon 2020 Week at SDU.**

The programme runs from 19th till the 21st of November and will cover all the major areas of Horizon 2020. So if you are a SDU researcher or staff working with EU – Horizon 2020 Week is *the* place to be. The programme is outlined below. SAVE THE DATE. More information will follow.

❖ International Network Programme 5th call published

The fifth call for International Network Programme has been published. This allows researcher at SDU to apply for funds for:

- **Workshops and conferences**
- **Visiting Scientist Grant**

The funds cover travel expenses, stay, transport, board etc. Collaboration with researchers from a number of countries is covered: **Brazil, China, Korea, Japan, India, USA and Israel.** In Horizon 2020 a greater emphasis will be put on involving partners from so called third countries such as China, USA, Korea, India etc. Involving researchers from these countries may be a plus in your application.

The deadline for application is **September 6th** and a total of 200.000 plus overhead can be applied for. The total funds for are 9 mio. DKK.

❖ Urban Europe – Call for Proposal

The Danish Council for Strategic Research supports the Joint Programme Initiative (JPI) Urban Europe with 500.000 EUR. This means that Danish researchers are eligible for funding. Urban Europe is a new Joint Programming Initiative. Its main aim is to coordinate research and make better use of Europe's public funds in order to: 1) Transform urban areas to centres of innovation and technology, 2) Realise eco-friendly and intelligent intra- and interurban transport and logistics systems 3) Ensure social cohesion and integration, and 4) Reduce the ecological footprint and enhance climate neutrality.

The two call topics are:

1. **Governance of urban complexity**

Cities are getting increasingly complex and new forms and structures for governance may be required to deal with this.

2. **Urban Vulnerability, Adaptability, and Resilience**

Enhance understanding of and response to natural, environmental, social, economic and technological shocks as well as gradual changes.

- Pre-proposal deadline: Sept 18th, 2013
- Short-list published: Nov, 2013
- Full proposal deadline: Jan 21st, 2014
- Funding decision announced: April, 2014
